

- 4, would ①時制の一致 I knew you would come back.
 ②過去の習慣 I would often make protein pancakes.
 ③仮定法 If I were you, I would join that team.
 ④過去の意志 She wouldn't say yes. (否定文：どうしても～しようとしなかった)

- 5, must ①義務 ～しなければならない (must not do：禁止：～してはいけない)
 I must do exercise every day. (自分の意志で筋トレする)
 You must not tell him the truth. (彼に真実を言うてはいけない)
 *have to との違い
 I have to do exercise every day. (医者とかに言われたから筋トレする)
 You don't have to tell him the truth. (彼に真実を言う必要はない)
- ②確信 ～にちがいない
 You must be sick.

- 6, shall ①Shall we ~? ～ませんか? Shall we have lunch together?
 ②Shall I ~? ～しましょうか? Shall I open the window?

- 7, should 義務 ～すべき You should practice hard.

提案・要求を表す動詞に続く節では **should** が来る(省略可)

I suggest that he should stay at my house.

→I suggest he stay at my house. (×stays)

他：advise, ask, agree, demand, desire, request, require,

必要性・感情・判断を表す語に続く節では **should** が来る(省略可)

It is 形容詞 that S should V.

It is strange that he should quit his job.

→It is strange he quit his job.

他：good, wrong, right, surprising, lucky
